

BAVARIAN TEXAS HOLD'EM

RULES OF THE
GAME



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INTRODUCTION

Bavarian Texas Hold'em is a card game based on Texas Hold'em. The game is played with a single deck of 52 cards. It is very simple and offers excellent chances of winning, as there is an additional optional bonus round.

You don't play against other players, just against the house. You don't have to wait until a poker round comes together, instead you can start whenever you like.

RULES OF THE GAME

Firstly, place your bets (ante) and a stake for the bonus bet, if you wish, and you will receive two cards face-down (hole cards) like all the other players and the dealer. Then, 5 cards are dealt face-up (common cards): First, three cards are laid (flop), then another (turn) and then one more (river). The best hand constituted of 5 cards is selected from your own hidden cards and the common cards and then compared to the dealer's. You win if you have a better hand than a dealer.

THE BETS

- The ante bet can range from a minimum of €5 to a maximum of €500.
- The bet for the bonus game is displayed on the relevant table.
- The player places their ante bet and an optional bet for the bonus game if they so wish.
- Now, two face-down hole cards are dealt to each player and the dealer.
- The player can now decide if they wish to continue playing or not. If they continue playing, they must place a bet onto the designated flop area which is the same value as the ante. The dealer takes the ante from all of the players that have folded.
- Now, three community cards (the flop) are laid face-up on the table.
- The player can now decide whether they want to make another bet on the turn card, at the same value as the ante, or check (continuing to play without putting in another bet).
- The fourth community card (the turn) is laid on the table face-up.
- The player can now decide whether they want to make another bet on the river card, at the same value as the ante, or check (continuing to play without putting in another bet).
- The fifth community card (the river) is laid on the table face-up.
- Now that all cards are laid on the table, the showdown begins. The best hand is created out of the two hole cards and the board, and the dealer compares their hand with the other players, one at a time from left to right.















OBTAIN PAYOUT

- The bonus game has added value.
- If the dealer has the better hand, all players lose their bets.
- If the player has the better hand, flop, turn and river bets are paid out at a ratio of 1:1. The ante bet is only paid out if the player has a straight hand or better.
- If the hands are of equal value, this is termed a standoff and the player simply gets their stake back.

WIN DISPLAY FOR BONUS GAME

The player's two hole cards are the deciding factor for winning, as are (only in the event of the highest win) the dealer's two hole cards. Otherwise, it doesn't matter which hand wins.
